Chappy Day Out is an annual event. Chaplains are invited to bring up to 5 students with whom they are trying to develop a more positive relationship. Through our outdoor, adventure based activities such as surfing and stand up paddle boarding, Chaplains foster a relationship built on a mutual experience, trust and understanding.

CYC Burleigh provides the qualified and experienced instructors, equipment, lunch and everything else needed for a great day out of the classroom. At the end of the day, students are presented with a certificate of participation and the satisfaction of knowing they've achieved something they wouldn't ordinarily do.

Chappy Day Out is a free event! Activities and lunch are provided free of charge in an effort to ensure all students have equal access to this event. Schools however, are responsible for transport to and from the Chappy Day Out.

Formed in 1945 and incorporated in 1976, CYC has been providing outdoor education experiences and holiday programs for over 70 years. The aim of the Chappy Day Out is to provide mentoring opportunities for Chaplains through outdoor, adventure based activities.
